

AHHS Class Of 1971 Reunion—Campus Changes, 2016

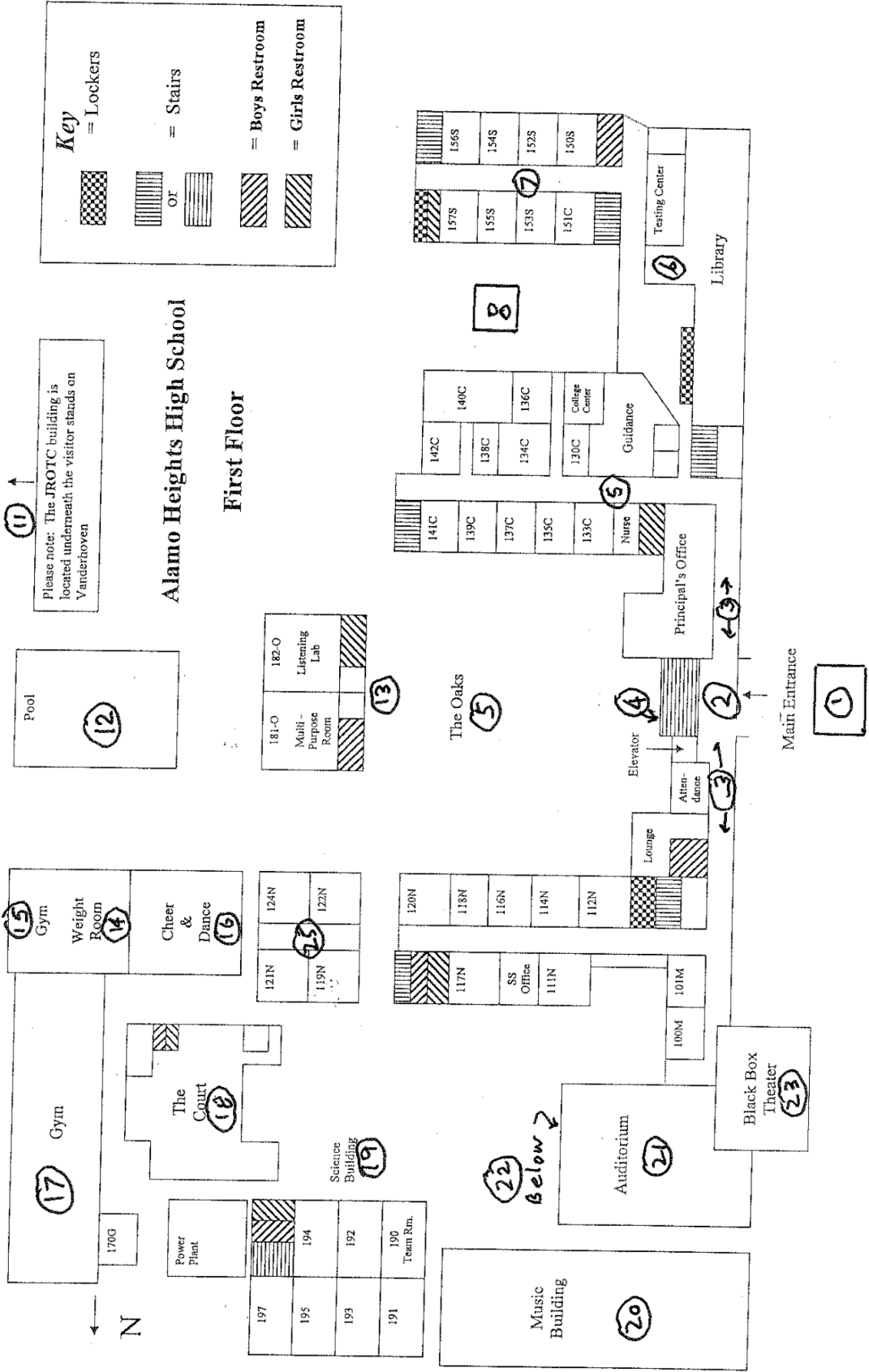

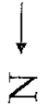
1. New mule statue outside front entrance
2. Main Entrance: Emblem is still here. Please do not step on it!
3. All Buildings now air conditioned, with insulated windows. Solar cells on roof supply power, with excess sold to City Public Service.
4. New stairs lead down to "The Oaks," the area between North and Central Wings.
5. Central Wing, downstairs, now houses Guidance, Nurse, Special Ed. and homemaking classrooms.
6. Library has doubled in size, with many computers for student use. It houses a new "Mule Stall" where students can study and snack.
7. South Wing, downstairs, now houses Foreign Language Classrooms.
8. New outdoor class facility between Central and South Wings
9. "Orem Stadium" now has artificial turf to save labor and water.
10. New Visiting Teams Locker Rooms building replaces Mule Stall.
11. New JROTC Building under East Grandstands
12. New Swimming Pool built in 1972.
13. Two-story "The Oaks" Building houses art, photography, meetings.
14. New Weight-Training Room replaces old Band Hall.
15. New "Sky Gym" is built above new Weight Room,
16. Little Gym is now called "Cheerleading and Dance Studio."
17. Big Gym, now named "The Mule Dome," has a *real* front entrance!
18. New Cafeteria, "The Court," built on the old Tennis Courts
19. New two-story Science Building replaces old Homemaking Cottage.

20. New Music Building on old Senior Parking Lot houses Band Hall, Choir Room, and Strings Room.
21. Auditorium refurbished with new seating and acoustic baffles. Windows eliminated. Multi-use Foyer at front of Auditorium
22. Rocketry Classroom and machine shop, and the Technology Department offices replace the old Cafeteria ("The Pit").
23. New "Black-Box Theater"
24. Credit Recovery upstairs in old typing and shorthand classrooms
25. North Wing includes a new 10-classroom Annex. Math Classes are still upstairs, Social Studies Classes are downstairs.
26. Foerster's 50-Year Plaque in North Wing Hall
27. Upstairs Main Hall has Senior Class Photos from many years!
28. Widened Central Wing Upstairs now houses Computer Labs, Multi-Media classrooms, Health classes, and others.
29. South Wing Upstairs now houses English Classes.
30. Elevators, open to all, are near Main Entrance and Auditorium.
